The extraordinarily rapid advances made in mathematics since World War II have resulted in analysis becoming an enormous organism spreading in all directions. Gone for good surely are the days of the great French courses of analysis which embodied the whole of the analytical knowledge of the times in three volumes-as the classical work of Camille Jordan. Perhaps that is why present-day textbooks of analysis are disproportionately modest relative to the present state of the art. More: they have retreated to the state before Jordan and Goursat. In recent years the scene has been changing rapidly: Jean Dieudonné is offering us his monumental Elements d'Analyse (10 volumes) written in the spirit of the great French Course d'Analyse. To the best of my knowledge, the present book is the only one of its size: starting from scratch-from rational numbers, to be precise-it goes on to the theory of distributions, direct integrals, analysis on complex manifolds, Kahler manifolds, the theory of sheaves and vector bundles, etc. My objective has been to show the young reader the...
