A. single bract may become so enlarged and folded as to inclose many flowers, which are arranged on a spadix. Such form of bract is termed a spathe (spatha, Lat. fruit-branch of a palm). It is either membranaceous, foliaceous, or woody (Fig. 108). Ex. Arum. If several bracts are arranged in a whorl or verticel around the base of certain kinds of inflorescence, such as an umbel or capitulum, such a verticel of bracts is called an involucre. Ex.
