One (xvii) is a lease, another (viii) a deed of exchange. Six (vii, xii-xv, xviii) may perhaps best be described as records of negotiations, the last being in the form of a letter. Five (n, x, xi, xii, xxi) are wills, including those of two kings, Alfred and Eadred. One (xix) is a deed of manumission. The two remaining (ix, xx) are dedicatory inscriptions in Mss. of the Gospels, relating to their origin or history. Apart from their historical importance these documents possess also considerable linguistic interest. Seven of them (i, II, IV, V, VII, IX, x) are written in the Kentish dialect, of which they are probably the earliest specimens; one (iii) is in Mercian and one (xx) in Northumbrian. The language of the rest is West Saxon, a dialect which seems eventually to have come into literary use...
