Prof. Loesch found that daily doses of 6 to 8 grms. of the sodium salt (sodium paracresotinicum) were readily borne by the human system, as well as by large dogs. A part of the acid passed through the system unchanged, and its presence in the urine was promptly shown by the violet color test with iron chloride. The urine of a dog after the administration of paracresotinic acid, or its sodium salt, was evaporated by heat, the cooled residue acidulated with muriatic acid, and agitated with ether, resulting in a combination of paracresotinic acid with the ether. By redistilling the ether the residue appeared in fused crystals: and by recrystallization of this residue pure paracresotinic acid was obtained. The product was identified...
